# Raw/Smackdown Supershow Results



#### **OPENING SEGMENT – RAW IN-RING**

The show opens with the entire arena bathed in red as Stephanie McMahon-Levesque, the new General Manager of RAW, stands in the ring with a podium covered in velvet cloth. She welcomes the WWE Universe to the RAW & SmackDown Supershow and announces that RAW is officially launching a new championship division.

She introduces DIY – Johnny Gargano & Tommaso Ciampa, newly signed from NXT, to a huge ovation. Stephanie reveals that due to their legacy as a team and their historic contributions to NXT, they are being crowned the inaugural World Tag Team Champions. She presents them with brand-new championship belts. DIY cuts an emotional promo about elevating tag team wrestling, vowing they'll defend against anyone, anywhere, starting tonight if necessary.

McAfee screams, "THIS IS A POWER MOVE FROM RAW!"

Barrett replies, "Enjoy it while it lasts—SmackDown still owns the REAL tag titles."

#### **BACKSTAGE - SMACKDOWN GM OFFICE**

The scene cuts to the blue-lit office of Vince McMahon, seated behind his desk like he's on a throne. Standing in front of him: Jon Moxley & Roman Reigns, the reigning WWE Tag Team Champions.

Vince smugly tells them they will defend the titles at Survivor Series against Gunther & Ilja Dragunov, whether they like it or not. He takes a jab at Seth Rollins, saying he's "glad that little Revolutionary brat is on Smackdown and someone else's problem now," claiming he did screw Seth over... before Seth screwed him.

Vince: "I practically GAVE his little ULW faction, The Vision, to CM Puke. Let him choke on it."

Reigns and Mox look annoyed, but silent. Mox spits on Vince's floor before walking out.

**MATCH 1 – CHAD GABLE vs BRAUN STROWMAN** 

(Non-title – Gable's IC Championship not on the line)

The match starts surprisingly competitive, with Gable using speed and technical skill to keep Braun off balance. But after being out-wrestled many times, Braun snaps. He grabs a steel chair and repeatedly assaults Gable, ignoring the referee's warnings.

Winner via DQ: Chad Gable

Braun continues the assault—and suddenly the lights go out.

When they return, The Hollow (Leader Joe Gacy, Dexter Lumis, and a pissed off Erick Rowan) are inside the ring with Braun. They surround the bloody Gable as he tries desperately to crawl away.

Then the theme "Snake Bit" hits.

Jake "The Snake" Roberts walks to the ring slowly with a sinister grin.

Jake gets in the ring, lifts Gable, and DDTs him. He then repeatedly punches Gable in the forehead until he bleeds heavily. Jake pulls out a contract, dips Gable's finger into the blood, and forces him to "sign."

Jake: "At Survivor Series, Gable... you belong to The Hollow. You're giving your title... to Gacy."



McAfee: "OH MY GOD THAT IS THE MOST DISTURBING THING I'VE EVER SEEN."

Barrett: "That's not a match announcement—that's a ritual."

**SEGMENT - "HIT AND SPEAR with BRET & BILL"** 



A backstage studio set decorated like a cheesy ESPN parody. Goldberg and Bret Hart sit on a velvet pew.

Goldberg opens by clarifying that The Minotaur is not a mythological beast, but just a guy named Chuck Ferrari that Goldberg went to college with, who owned a furry costume and "too many Disney VHS tapes."

Bret wishes Mickey Mouse a happy birthday month, then casually praises FTR and Brock Anderson, saying "Brock reminds me of his dad... but with better hair."

Goldberg glares and says, "I'll never understand you, Bret. If you would have taken better care of yourself during your career, this would've made more sense to me. You want to talk about a trio nobody cares about and I am trying to explain to you that Minotaur is a crossdresser!"

Bret: "You listen here Bill Goldberg! I am only on this stupid show with you because our Legends contract requires it! I would love to kick your ass...... but that is all the time we have for today's edition of Hit and Spear. Remember to always be the best there is...the best there

was...and the best you can be! We will be back next Monday!"

**BACKSTAGE - RAW GM OFFICE** 

Stephanie McMahon-Levesque announces that Damian Priest will defend the World Championship against former champion John Cena at Survivor Series.

> Stephanie: "Cena never got his rematch clause honored against Jesse. He gets an opportunity now."

McAfee loses his mind: "THE CHAMP IS BACK!"

MATCH 2 - RHEA RIPLEY (c) vs RAQUEL RODRIGUEZ

## Women's World Championship

A hard-hitting power match. Raquel nearly wins after a Tejana Bomb, but Rhea rakes the eyes, hits Riptide, and retains.

Winner & STILL Champion: Rhea Ripley

But before she can celebrate—TRISH STRATUS' music hits!

Trish walks to the ring, stares down Rhea, and challenges her for Survivor Series.

Rhea accepts immediately, nose-to-nose.

**MAIN SEGMENT - CONTRACT SIGNING** 

Seth Rollins and The Rock sit at opposite sides of the table, the WWE Championship around the Rock's waist. The crowd duels with chants: "Rocky!" / "Burn It Down!"



Before tensions reach boiling point—Triple H's music hits. He walks out with someone beside him:

Mr. Murrey.

(The crowd reacts with confusion—still no clear job title.)

Triple H hands Murrey the mic. Murrey announces a major twist for the Survivor Series main event:

Murrey: "The Rock. Seth Rollins. WWE Championship. But there will be someone watching every move... someone who doesn't answer to anyone except me!"

"Your special guest referee is—JESSE 'THE BODY' VENTURA!"

The crowd explodes. The Rock and Seth stare at each other, then at the announcement graphic as the show ends.
